

Newspaper Wreath Tutorial

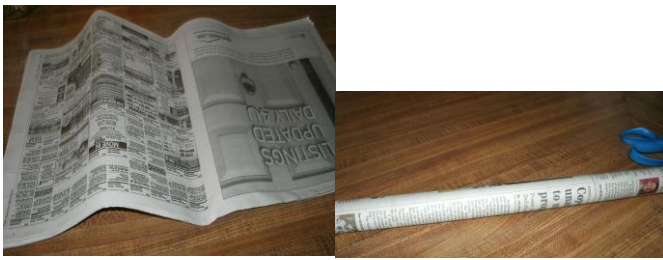


Supplies Needed

- Newspapers Approximately 30 sheets (I used the Sunday Paper)
- Masking Tape
- Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun
- Spray Paint
- Embellishments



Step 1



- Take 8 – 10 sheets of paper and roll them up
- Do this twice

Step 2



- Scrunch and twist each piece

Step 3



- Wrap Masking Tape around the individual sections

Step 4



- Join the sections with masking tape

The circle will be thin at this point.

Step 5:



- Take 4 sheets of paper fold them in half
- Wrap these sheets around the newly formed circle followed by a round of tape.
- Continue to do this until the circle is well formed.



Now that you have your wreath form you will need to make the covering.

Step 6:



- Line up 20 sheets of paper
- Fold all of them in half together

Step 7:



- Cut $\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips up just over halfway so there is about 2 inches left before the fold

Do this all the way along the paper edge.

Step 8:

Now that you have made all your cuts you need to separate your papers so you can fold them around the wreath. Just cut right down the fold all the way across. This way you will have many individual strips.



Step 9:

- Take one strip and wrap it around the wreath form. Glue or tape the end.
- Place another strip overlapping just slightly the first one. Glue or tape the end.
- Continue to do this all the way around the wreath until you come to the beginning again.



Step 7:

Once you get to the end you will have to fold your strips into halves to fit them in. This is the point where you will put your ribbon or ?? so, it most likely will not show.



Step 8:

- Paint
Spray from a distance and be patient. Shake the wreath occasionally as you paint to



keep your papers from sticking together. You will get messy! So, wear gloves, mask etc for safety.

- Once the wreath is completely dry, add all your embellishments.
